Ingrow Station hosts a stunning display of engineering ingenuity.

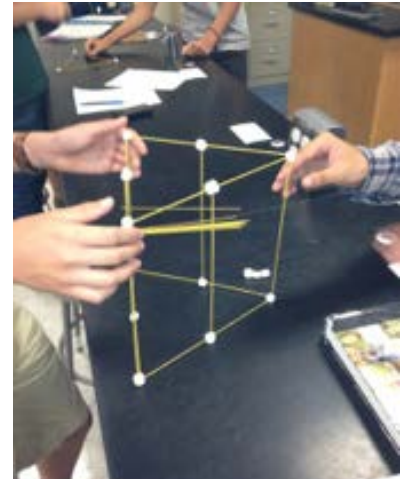
This 'science and engineering week' we have an opportunity for you to discover the great locomotive engines that inspired the world.
